



Name of the Program: Field Visit to special School, Dr. Narendra Bhivapurkar Blind School, Amravati.


Name of the Activity: Online Orientation Lecture on National Voters Day


Name of the Program: Visit to "Madhuban" Old Age Home, Bhankheda






